

Carolyn Trowbridge, a vibraphonist and percussionist who is a major part of the Austin, Texas music scene, makes her debut as a leader on *Found Memories*. Her regular quartet is augmented with several other musicians, most notably flutist Alex Coke, creating ensemble-oriented performances full of color, drama, unpredictable grooves and variety.

In Austin, Texas, vibraphonist Carolyn Trowbridge is greatly in demand for performances and recordings whether it is with rock bands, Afrobeat ensembles, avant-garde jazz units, steel pan groups, or vocalists. Her versatility is as impressive as her musicianship and creativity.

For Found Memories, her recording debut as a leader, her core quartet with guitarist Bryan Sunderman, bassist Mario Castellanos, and drummer/percussionist Nick Tozzo is joined on various selections by flutist Alex Coke, harpist Elaine Barber, tenor-saxophonist Jason Frey, and the voice of Caitlin Palmer. Carolyn Trowbridge performs ten of her originals, music that is as colorful as her song titles. While there are concise vibes, guitar and flute solos, the emphasis is on the ensembles and the development of her pieces.

Found Memories starts off with the joyful opener "Thank You For The Memories, Thank You For The Laughs," a danceable performance that is full of joy. In contrast, "Duchess Of Sheba" is a menacing strut that lets one know that the Duchess is not someone to be messed with. "Chopin's Séance" is a bit otherworldly, episodic, and includes a dreamlike ballad section for Trowbridge's vibes.

The rhythmically infectious "Grackle vs. Tacotarian" could be used as a soundtrack for an imaginary battle; Alex Coke, as the grackle, creates some odd sounds on his flute that fit the plot of the piece. "The Lonely Frost Flower" is mysterious and lightly funky while "Tookey's Engine" sounds like a train ride on a magical journey. Other selections include the happy jazz piece "Turtle Heart," "The Old Woman Who Never Grew Older" (one can certainly feel the presence of the distinguished subject during this unhurried performance), "Physalia's Journey" which includes a spot for Frey's tenor, and the optimistic groove of "Onward."

Carolyn Trowbridge has been a significant part of the music scene in Austin as a performer and an educator for some time. She has worked with such local performers as Black Pumas, Adrian Quesada, Graham Reynolds, Star Parks, Hard Proof, and among others. Her diverse experiences include performing with the choir Conspirare: A Company of Voices for a PBS special, an Austin City Limits live taping with Boleros Psicodelicos, supporting Snoop Dogg, and playing with Mike Portnoy. She has also been a music educator for over 20 years and delivered master classes all over the U.S.

The vibraphonist founded her quartet (which currently also includes tenor-saxophonist Jason Frey, bassist Mario Castellanos and drummer Andy Beaudoin) in 2023. Now, with the upcoming release of *Found Memories*, her artistry will be in evidence to any listener who enjoys melodic, dramatic and unpredictable music.
